Subject: Variation Notice Verification Charges

UL believes in the importance of public safety and providing our customers with excellent, high-quality service. Part of this commitment includes keeping our customers apprised of changes that may affect them. Effective July 1, 2007, UL will implement a Variation Notice Verification Fee to determine that all variations described in the Variation Notice have been addressed and products carrying the UL Mark continue to comply with the requirements, thus ultimately protecting the integrity of the UL Mark.

The Variation Notice Verification Fee is US\$500 and will be invoiced after all items on the Variation Notice have been verified as complete. In the past, these Fees were sometimes captured as additional inspections or through special charges.

This Fee will be applied only if your product is found to be non-compliant and a Variation Notice is issued. To prevent Variation Notices, submit any product construction changes to UL for evaluation and acceptance before they are incorporated into products that are intended to bear the UL Mark.

Safety is our number one priority and we remain committed to promoting the production of safer products on behalf of end-users and manufacturers alike. UL encourages all subscribers to take a proactive role in complying with the UL procedures and standards.
